Production for 1939 (1938):

Dynamite: 190 (130) tons, worth 4.11 (3.16) million dinars.

Other explosives: 580 (93) tons, worth 9.32 (1.40) million dinars.

Shells and detonators: 15 (23) tons, worth 949 thousand (1.4 million dinars.

25 May 1942, "Die Chemische Industrie,"

The "Chemical Factories, Inc." was recently founded with a capital of 50 million dinars. It will produce materials for use in agriculture.'

In addition to the "Drava" explosives factory, the following enterprises manufacture explosives and combustibles:

Titanit Corporation for the Chemical Industry, in Mahicno, near Karlovoc.

(belongs to I. G. Farbon; produces explosives and all materials needed for the manufacture of ammunition)

Pira Corporation, for the production of industrial, mining, and agricultural materials, Zabreb.

(Capital: 1.2 million Kura; deals in explosives, fuses, pyrotechnis materials, etc.)

Match Company of the Independent State of Creatia, Zagreb.

(Belongs to Svenska Tendstisks, Inc., Jänkeping, Sweden; produces 70,000 boxes of matches per year)

First Bosnian-Herzegovinian Explosives Corporation, in Dolse na Lasvi.

(Capital: 22 x 2.1 million kuna; directed by the Match Company of the Independent State of Croatia since the founding of the state of Croatia)

26 June 1942, Chemische Industrie, No 25/20

The "Titanit Corporation for the Chemical Industry," in Mahicno, near Karlovac, which belongs to X. G. Farban, Leverkusen, and manufactures explosives, has decided to halt the liquidation of the firm and to reorganize as the "Corporation for Explosives and Chemical Products," reducing capital from eight million to four million kuna.

26 June 1942, Chemische Industrie, No 25/26

The "Bynamit-Nobel Corporation, Belgrade," founded with a capital of one million dinars, will produce explosives and detonating materials for mining, also fertilizers of all sorts. It will also conduct experiments on the efficient use of fertilizers. It will have a special branch, "Oranica", for the sale of fertilizers. The firm will also start production of paints and varnishes, taking over the branch of the Varnish and Oil Industry Corporation (Zagreb) which is located in Serbia.
