Publisher's Note

The book was published for the 33d anniversary of the Great October Russian Revolution. The aim of the publication is "to acquaint the reader with the general lines of the historic fight of the Soviet Union for peace and progress of humanity." The foreword makes the claim that the USSR will be victorious in its fight for peace of all progressive humanity not only because truth is on its side, and she is supported by all peace-loving population, but also because the greater strength is on her side.

The book is divided into four comprehensive parts, describing, on a popular level, the economy, the scientific and technical advances, and the military strength of the USSR, and describes the fight being carried on for peace. The book consists in part of original manuscript and partly of quotations from speeches and articles.

In the above categories, the book gives an historical summary, as well as the extent of recent developments. The political tone of the book suggests it might be kept in Hungarian military ward rooms, community houses, etc. The table of contents follows.
