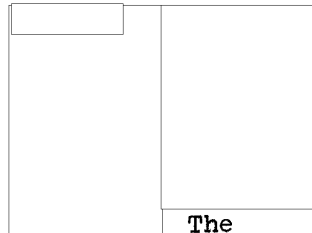

The strength of the unit was about 500 officers and EM. The men wore old US or British uniforms colored dark green. Labor Bn. officers wore Polish Navy uniforms; engineer or technical officers wore Polish Infantry uniforms, which were dark green with red cap bands.

Until sometime in 1950 or 1951, exact date unknown, the PLO was known as the Gdynia-America Line (GAL - Gdynia-Ameryka Linia). The PLO was subordinate to the Ministry of Navigation (MZ - Ministerstwo Zeglugi), located in WARSZAWA Δ N 52-15, E 21-007, Ulica (Street) Filtrowa, 4.
