1. Uniformed MVD checked documents of all personnel (military and civilian) who traveled by train through the Western Ukraine.

2. MVD boarded trains at the Mukachevo /N 48-26, E 22-437 and Stryi /N 49-15, E 23-507 railroad stations

[Redacted] MVD officer complained about his job which was described as a "dog's life - pulling you up at all hours of the night to go on raids and round up murderers."

3. During checks, the MVD did not stamp or mark documents in any manner. [Redacted] the MVD only accompanied the train while on Western Ukrainian territory. No checks by the MVD were made beyond the Western Ukraine. Baggage was not inspected nor were body searches made.
