- Q. Factory No 19 is located in Molotov and is reported to be called Stalin and to be engaged in the manufacture of aero-engines. Can you describe its exact location and present activity?
- A. A streetcar line Point #1 went directly to this plant by way of Lenin St (Ulitsa Lenina). The area occupied by Factory No 19 Point #2 is called Stalin; it manufactures either aircraft engines or aircraft engine parts. The plant operated on three shifts. A highway Point #3 connected Molotov with Kungun 5725N-5656E. A single track railroad Point #4 connected the plant with Kungur.

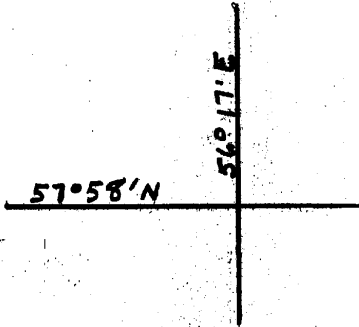
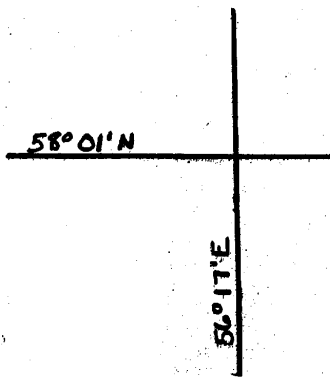
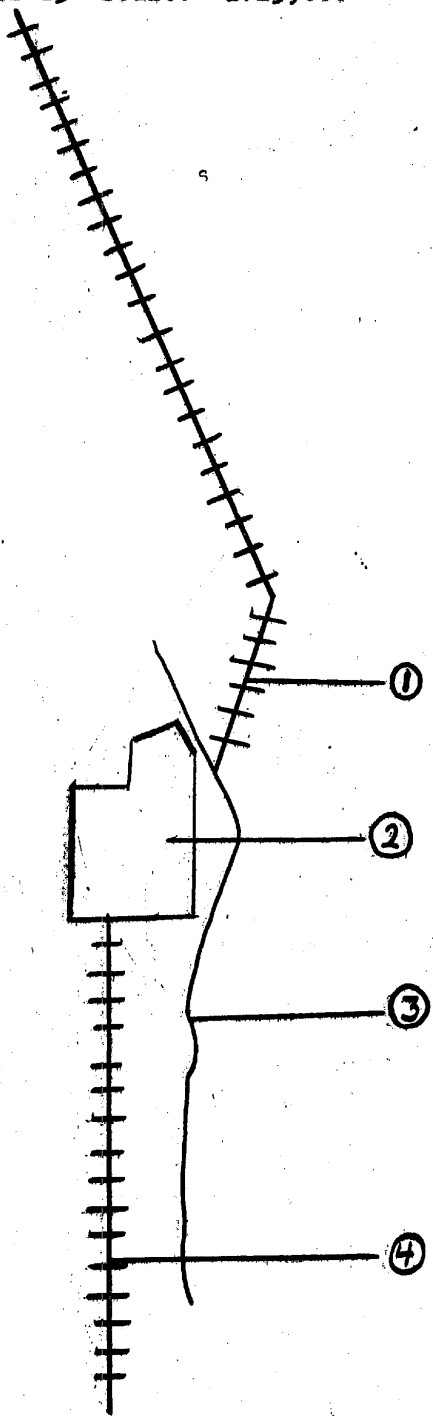
