CONSIDERATION OF EIC-R1-S6, "COMMUNIST CHINA'S IMPORTS AND EXPORTS, 1956: TRADE AND TRANSPORT INVOLVED"

2. Discussion:

The draft report on "Communist China's Imports and Exports, 1956: Trade and Transport Involved" (EIC-R1-S6), prepared and approved by the Working Group, was reviewed. The Chairman indicated that he considered this report the best in the series and that the Working Group members should be commended for their preparation of the report. Mr. Terrill also indicated that he considered the report of high quality and the members of the Working Group deserving of commendation. The other members concurred.
