EIC COMMENTS ON REPORT OF THE SCIENTIFIC ESTIMATES COMMITTEE,
"COORDINATION OF GUIDED MISSILES INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES"
(IAC-D-81/10)

1. Discussion: This special meeting of the EIC was called to prepare a written EIC comment on the SEC paper "Coordination of Guided Missiles Intelligence Activities" (IAC-D-81/10). It was noted by members that the IAC instruction had called for SEC's "coordinating" the preparation of this paper with the EIC whereas the document had actually been prepared unilaterally. [REDACTED] 25X1A9a explained that he had made certain suggestions to the SEC Chairman as to changes in the wording of the SEC draft which he believed would have made it acceptable to the EIC; but these had not been accepted by the SEC members. Accordingly it had been agreed that comments by the EIC would be submitted separately prior to the IAC meeting on 12 July 1955.

2. Action: The members agreed in the wording of the attached statement with two footnotes indicating points on which the members were not fully agreed. ✓
