

1. Communist Liaison Networks

KAO Yang (高揚), head of the Shanghai Communist Political Defense Bureau, and LI Yang (李陽) (敬?), political commissioner, are planning to establish a liaison headquarters in the area where Tifeng Road crosses Route Duplex.* This will later be extended to form a network with other places in Shanghai. Liaison communication lines will run through residential districts, parks and other places. Each line will include five small units, and each unit will consist of about five persons, including men, women, and children.

2. Liaison Office

CHU Pin-jeu (朱秉仁), staff officer under HUANG Ko-cheng (黃克誠), Communist commander in Northern Kiangsu, has arrived in Shanghai to establish liaison headquarters in Shanghai.

3. Shanghai Branch of the Intelligence Office of the Communist Central China Military Area

The Communist Central China Military Area, in an effort to obtain information concerning Nationalist activities in the present conflict, has established an Intelligence Office in Shanghai at 84 Route Vallon with YU Hai-feng (俞海峯) as the director.

4. Mobilization Committee

On 25 August the Shanghai Communist Committee received an order from Yenan to organize a mobilization committee in Shanghai. FAN Wen-li (范文瀾), secretary of the Shanghai Communist Committee, assigned LI Tien-tsai (黎天才) to take charge of organizing the new committee. The purpose of this new committee is to mobilize the local leftist students and laborers

5. Investigation of Government Officials

Kao Yang (高陽), head of the Investigation and Research Section of the Shanghai Communist Committee, called a meeting of his staff members on 1 September to give them instructions for their work in the month of September. Each member of the section was given investigation forms and is responsible for the investigation of one government official: the name, address, life history, and activities of each official must be filled in the investigation blank form. Completed forms must be returned to the section.

6. Replacement of Communists

On 2 September T'ao Hsing-chien (譚行健), an official of the Shanghai Communist Committee has decided to replace fifteen Communist members who are under the scrutiny of Government agents. These include: Wu I (吳毅), a party member, Tang Hsien-k'ün (楊獻坤) and Meng Chia-liang (孟家良), political instructors, and Liu Chia-yuan (劉克遠), an official in the students' movement.

7. Resumption of Publication by Chou Pao Publishing Company

After having been suspended for over a month, the Chou Pao has resumed publication through the efforts of the Leftists. Besides Chin Chung and Chou Pao, the Chou Pao Publishing Company will also publish a book entitled "Political and Economic Problems" which was written by Mao Tse-tung. This book will be sold at the Life Book Store, the Writers Book Store and the China Cultural Investment Company.

8. The First Sino-Soviet Round Table Conference

The first Sino-Soviet Cultural Workers Round Table Conference for the exchange of political opinion was recently held in the Russian Club on Ave. Each attended by more than twenty persons. Chang Teao-chain (張迺新) presided over the meeting. Kuo Mo-jo (郭沫若), a Communist writer, made a report on the crisis of Chinese Democracy.

9. Communist Women's Activities
