- 1. Hungarian factories continue to work for the Russians within the framework of the reparations demands. Aircraft, shipping, bauxite and oil are the principal industries being developed. As a result of agreements with these four industrial groups, the Russians have now practically a monopoly on the products from their factories and plants.
- 2. The bauxite industry, under the new name "Soviet-Humgarian Company" delivers the largest part of its production to Russia.
- 3. The Ganz carriage firm is turning out modern aluminum coaches, called "Silve-trains", for the Moscow-Lemingrad railroad line.
- 4. The steel which Sweden is to deliver to Hungary under a recent trade agreement is for Russian purposes and some of it is to be turned into what appears to be tank armor plate. The director of the Skandinavska Bank, which is handling a large Swedish loan to Russia, was recently in Budapest to study the question of the Hungarian steel deliveries.
