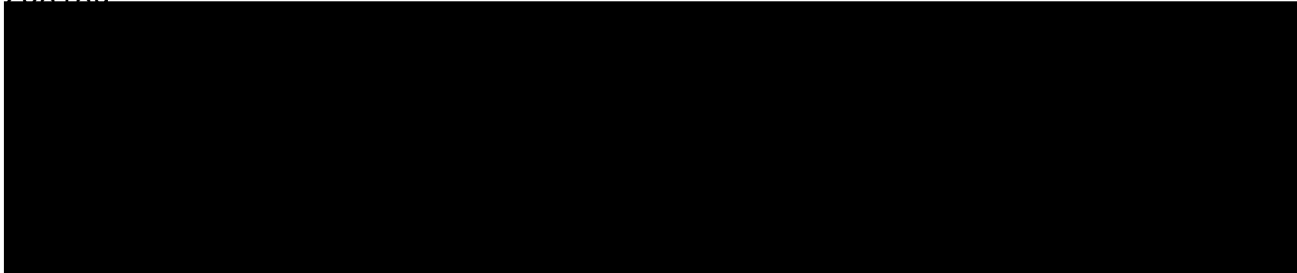

1. There are 2,600 locomotives in Yugoslavia today. Of this number, 1,700 are in operation including the 80 locomotives delivered in March by UNRRA while the remainder are undergoing repairs. The best 20 locomotives were taken by the Russians.
2. There are approximately 45,000 railroad cars of all kinds on the Yugoslav railroads. The Russians took 700 cars as a "thank-offering" from Serbia for the latter's liberation.
