

SUPPLEMENT



- The following MVD units destined for the protection of the Soviet Ambassy are subordinate to the Operational Branch: a Radio Battalion and two Rifle Battalions, all of which are commanded by Lt. Col. Jakoview. The Rifle Battaliens perform sentry duties around the areas occupied by the Soviet Embassy; the Radio Battalion carries out w/t interception.
- The interception points which work day and night with shifts changed every six hours are located as follows:
 - a. Main point (also location of the above three battalions) 2 Kielsoks Street, corner of Narbuta St.
 - 0. At the crossing of Oserniakowska Street and the Wilanow highway; this is a square covering an area of at least ten hectares surrounded with barbed wire and strictly guarded.
 - c. Opposite the Okecie sirfield, near the Warsaw-Radon highway. This point pays special attention to landings and take-offs of all planes at the Okecte airfields. The airfield authorities have been ordered to submit all traffic reports to the interception point. The latter is, therefore, in a position to check the authenticity of reports by comparing them with data at hand.
