SUPPLEMENT

1. On 18 October the Society for Fighting Jewry distributed their pamphlet No.10 which set forth the names, occupations, and methods of spreading propaganda of ten Jews in Alexandria. These ten, the pamphlet states, are directing the Zionist movement and are spending a good deal of money on their propaganda. A pamphlet will be dedicated to each of the ten.

2. On 24 October pamphlet No.11 appeared, many copies of which were sent through the ordinary mail. As promised in the preceding pamphlet, this one is devoted to a certain Jacques Goar, whom the author believes to be the leader of the Alexandria propagandist movement. Goar, a merchant at Minet-al-Bassal, is accused of penetrating sports circles, spending a lot of money, and corrupting the idle, the rich, and the young. He receives his money from the Jewish Agency in Palestine; from the Jews in Egypt who subscribe to a fund, the purpose of which is to spread propaganda; and from the British Propaganda Office on the pretext of using it in the interests of the British. He managed, by using Abd-al-Gulil Kennawi of Alexandria, to organize "The Brothers of Liberty," a society ostensibly formed to work for the British, but actually working for the Zionists. The Society is located at Sharia Fardos, Muharrem Bey district, Alexandria. (The above is a digest of the pamphlet.)

Comment: Source has been unsuccessful in tracing the origin of the pamphlets. It was reported to to at one time that they were the work of the Ikhwan al-Muslimin, but it is thought in some circles that they

are produced by one man, perhaps even a Jew, and are possibly intended to encourage Jewish immigration from Egypt to Palestine.
