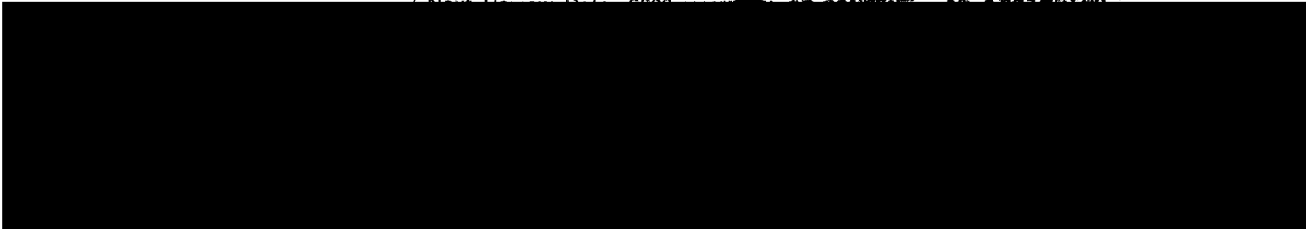

ORIGIN



1. About 500 persons entered Slovakia from the Carpatho-Ukraine during November under the provision of the Czechoslovak-Soviet treaty permitting option for either country to certain persons. It is believed by well informed men in Slovakia that half of these 500 were sent over by the Russians to act as agents.
2. According to reliable informants coming from Carpatho-Ukraine, there is said to be a sharp increase in Red Army troops in the Carpatho-Ukraine since the end of October.
3. Red Army troops force the population of entire villages to take their belongings and to leave immediately by train or trucks for the interior of Soviet Russia.
