

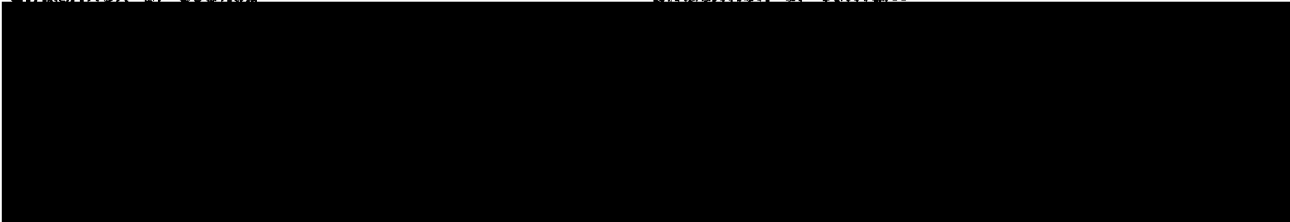

1. There is a combined hydro and steam-driven electric power plant on the Oka River at Alexin. Electricity from this plant is carried as far as Moscow. In addition, there are munitions and metal works in Alexin. 25X1X6
2. Railroads in the neighborhood of Alexin are being double-tracked with material from dismantled German lines. In the summer of 1946 the line between Tula and Kaluga was still single-tracked.
