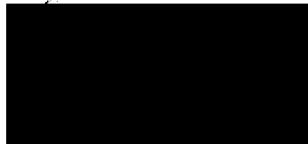

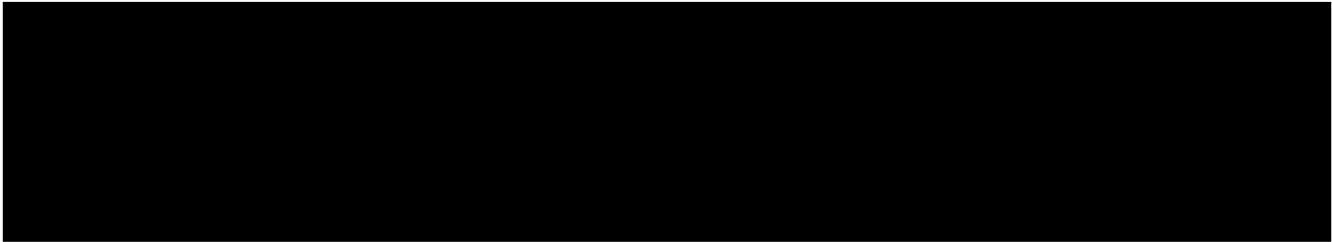

1. The 6th Automobile Group, commanded by Captain Francisco Sierra, is garrisoned in BURGOS, 6th Military Region. The chief of the Motor Fuel and Materials Depot (Deposito de Carburantes e Ingredientes) of this Group is Captain Emilio Salsz Mas; Manuel Paredes Lora is the ranking captain.
2. The 61st and 69th workshop companies and the staff of the 5th Automobile Group also are located in BURGOS. The 5th Automobile Group has detachments in PAMPLONA and BILBAO.
3. There are forty new three to five-ton Ford trucks, 150 small Chevrolet trucks in good condition, forty Studebakers, and fifty touring cars of various makes in the Automobile Park of Burgos. There are also 10,000 new spare parts for trucks and 15,000 new spare parts for touring cars in the Park at Burgos, as well as a reserve of sixty tons of gasoline.
4. There are fifty trucks in Pamplona which are used for transporting stone and cement destined for the fortifications of the Pyrenees frontier.
