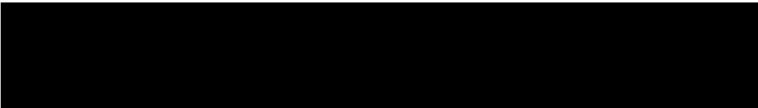
1. The Nationalist 2 Division moved to Pu-ta-yuan (125-20, 40-55).
2. There are 3000 Japanese troops being used by the Communists in Shu-lan (126-48, 44-21). The main force of these troops is at Mu-tan-chiang (129-37, 44-35). The Nationalist Northeast Command Headquarters estimates that there are six regiments.
3. Communist unit dispositions follow:
 20 Army Hq /shown on SO-2588/ Lin-tung (118-58, 43-51)
 N 3 Division Shu-lan
 7 Division (main force) area north of Wu-chia-chan (125-41, 44-59)

4. Communist troops, trained by the Soviets, are holding maneuvers around Tang-chia-feng-tun (122-13, 39-25).
 There are 5000 Communists retreating due east of Chin-chuan (126-09, 42-26). Elements of the Nationalist Temporary 21 and New 30 Divisions are following this retreat.

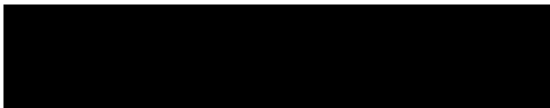

5. The main force of the 5 Garrison Brigade, which was moving southeast, is now twenty miles west of Ping-tu (119-56, 36-47).
 The 7 Emancipation Division is recruiting near Tien-chen (117-49, 37-12).
 The 10 Emancipation Division is comprised of the former 8 and 9 Garrison Brigades, with headquarters at Lin-i (118-24, 35-07). The commander is General HO Chien 賀健 and the deputy commander is HU Te-ching 胡德清.
