- The Nationalist 2 Division moved to Pu-ta-yuan (125-20, 40-55).
- 2. There are 3000 Japanese troops being used by the Communists in Shu-lan (126-48, 44-21). The main force of these troops is at Mu-tan-chiang (129-37, 44-35). The Mationalist Northeast Command Readquarters estimates that there are six regiments.
