History: Organized in January-February 1946 in Łęczyca

Miscellaneous: 1. Aircraft markings changed from Soviet to Polish in February 1946.

2. In February-March 1946, the 3rd, 4th, and 7th air Regiments (stationed as follows: 3rd or 5th in Sochaczew, and 4th in Janiki, 30 km from Sochaczew) were deactivated and their aircraft (67 PE-2s) transferred to the Łęczyca field, where they remain inactive.
