EVALUATION OF CONTENT

1. At the beginning of September 1946, five Soviet officers completed an investigation connected with the diversion of the Karadza River near Zmeitva in order to provide more electric power in and around Trichia. It is understood that a three-fold increase in the supply will result when the proposed plan is completed.
2. This development is believed to be connected with the arrival of Soviet troops in the locality. One battalion of the Bulgarian 2nd Labor Regiment has already begun work on the project. Two senior engineers were expected to arrive in mid-October to supervise the work.
3. The arsenal at Kazanlik now employs about 2,500 workmen and has recently been accepting such civilian work as the repair of agriculture machinery.
