Most of the Mongolians in Chahar Province have a strong antipathy for the newlyappointed Hoshun Chiefs because all of these men were among those who fled to a comparatively safe and comfortable life in Peiping after the Japanese surrender. The people who actually suffered hardships by remaining in Chahar feel that the Nationalist Government would not reinstate these men in public offices without 25X1X7 first considering the desires of the people of Inner Mongolia.
