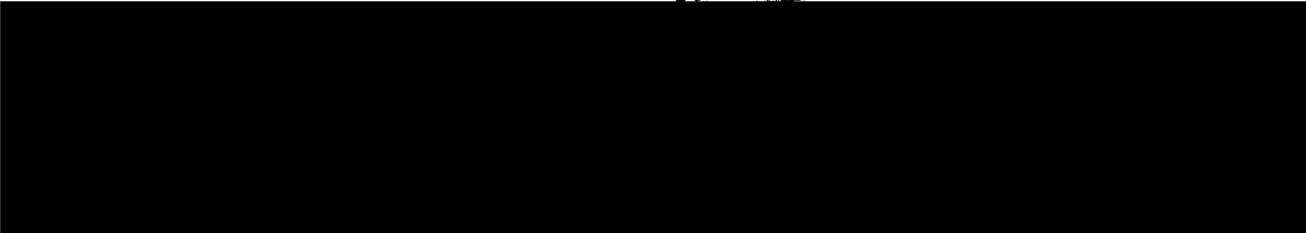

Place	Principal crops	Harvest
Chiaoho (127-20,43-43)	Rice, red beans, corn. Very little kaoliang.	Average; food as usual, was imported into the district.
Mutauchiang (129-37,44-35)	Kaoliang, corn, wheat.	Below average.
Tungpei (126-52,47-59)	Corn and millet. Tobacco grown for first time this year.	Fairly good.
Faichuan (126-17,47-33)	Millet, soy beans, corn, some kaoliang.	Very good.
Tuman (129-49,42-58)		Two sources state there is plenty of food in the area, as the Communists use it as a food distribution point.
Antu (128-22,43-34)		Food is plentiful.
Tsitsihar (123-57,47-22)	Five sources reported. All mentioned kaoliang as a principal crop. Millet, potatoes, soy beans, wheat, and corn were each mentioned by two sources. Barley, cabbage, turnips, and rice were mentioned once.	One source said crop conditions were good; the other four that they were below normal. Three of the latter attributed this to drought.
Lungching (129-26,42-47)		Very good, according to one source; double the average according to another.
