1. At the freight station in Altenburg (K-27) twenty-six World War I model, 210 mm fortress guns were observed; the gun barrel was approximately two meters long. Thirteen of the guns were on gun carriages with wheels one meter in diameter, and the remaining thirteen were self-propelled.
2. An artillery unit with vehicle numbers in T O 06++ series are quartered in barracks near Altenburg station. Forty-three modern guns were observed, and others were parked in sheds; thirty were 150mm long-barreled guns, and the other thirteen were 150mm field howitzers with split trails.
3. At Borna (K-39) a tank unit is quartered in barracks near the station with vehicles numbered III 1 39 12, III 1 36 48, etc. Twenty-one T-34s (five bogies, long-barreled 76.2mm gun) were observed, three of them being numbered 304, 306, and 309.
