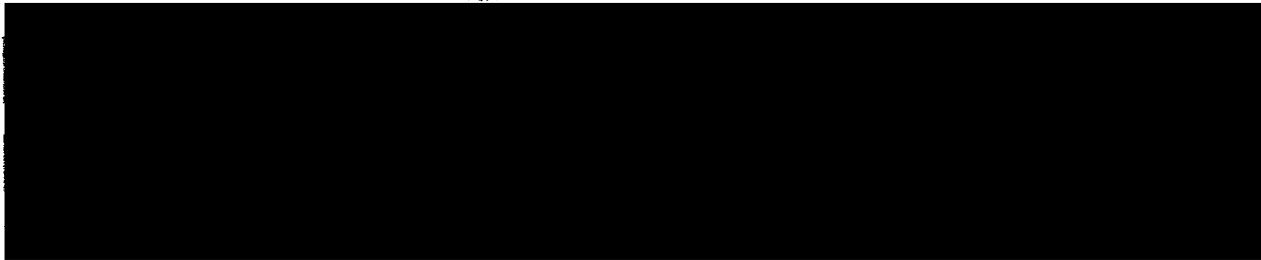

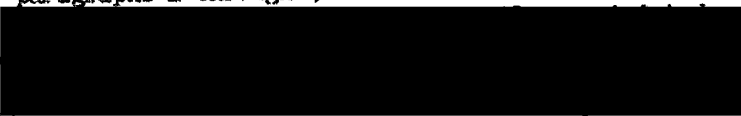
- Two sources say that the head of the Nenchiang Province Provisional government is YU Yi-fu (于毅夫); the other says his name is WU (吴).
- One source gives the Mayor of Tsitsihar as CHU (朱), another as WANG (王).
- One source says the Tsitsihar city government has a Police Department, Finance Department, and a Training Department. Another source says there is a Foreign Department under CHANG (张). The latter is assisted by three Japanese: YAMASHITA (山下), HAYASHI (林), and INOUE (井上).
- The Headquarters of the Nenchiang Military District is at Tsitsihar. None of the three sources knew the name of the commander. All three knew that the second in command was WANG Ming-kuei (王明贵). One source commented that WANG was widely known for his work as a Communist during the Japanese occupation; another that WANG was considered a troublemaker by the Japanese during the Manchukuo regime. The third source comments that he believes there is no commander, and that Vice-Commander WANG is the actual head of the 8th Route forces in the area.

5. Since 10 October, Communists at Tsitsihar have effected a general political and military reorganization. New posts are held as follows:

- a. CHU Kuang (朱光), Political Commissioner of Western Manchuria.
- b. HUANG Ping-nan (黃炳南), Commander of Western Manchuria Military Area.
- c. WANG Ming-kuei (王明貴), Vice Commander under HUANG [REDACTED] 25X1X6
- d. YÜ Yi-fu (于毅夫), Governor of Nenchiang Province (see paragraph 1.)
- e. WANG Kuang-wei (王光偉), Chief Secretary under YÜ
- f. LI Han (厲南), Chief of Police Department
- g. CHANG Shao-p'ing (張紹平), Chief of Industrial Department
- h. MA Chün (馬鈞), Chief of Western Manchuria Railway Office
- i. LIANG Chiu-kuang (梁九光), Chief of Electrical Telegraph Office
- j. CHU Hsin-t'ang (朱新湯), Mayor of Tsitsihar (see Paragraph 1.)
- k. HAN Li-chung (韓立中), Vice Mayor of Tsitsihar
- l. LIU Lien-nan (劉鍊男), Director of Public Safety
- m. CH'IAO Ming Yüan (喬鳴遠), Vice Director under LIU
