

- Two sources say that the head of the Nenchiang Province Provisional government is YU Yi-fu"(于毅夫); the other says his name is WU (吴)。
- 2. One source gives the Layor of Tsitsihar as CMU (**), enother as WANG
- 3. One source says the Tsitsihar city government has a Police Department, Finance Department, and a Training Department. Another source says there is a Foreign Department under CHANG (美)。 The latter is assisted by three Japanese: YAMASHITA (山 下), HAYASHI (本), and INOUYE (共
- The Headquarters of the Nenchiang Military District is at Tsitsihar. None of the three sources knew the name of the commander. All three knew that the second in command was WANG hing-kuei (F). One source commented that WANG was widely known for his work as a Communist during the one source 25X1X6 Japanese occupation; another that WANG was considered a troublemaker by the Jupanese during the Manchukuo regime. The third source comments that he believes there is no commender, and that Vice-Commender WANG is the actual head of the 8th Route forces in the area.
