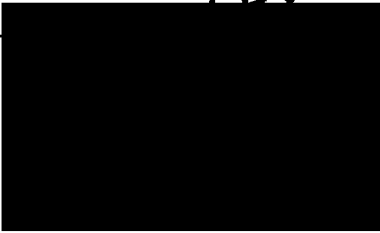

- The Soviet Administration of Soviet Property in Austria (USIVA, Starhenberggasse 4-6, Vienna IV) has made the following demands: 25X1A6a
 Bruenn Glass Factory to pay 1,500,000 schillings. Comment: Possibly Erste Oesterreichische Maschinenglasindustrie AG, Brunn am Gebirge)
 Moosbrunn Gluehlampen Factory to pay 20,000 schillings
 These sums are to defray "management costs" (Verwaltungskosten) and are to be placed with the Soviet Bank (GOS Bank, Vienna).
- The head of the Soviet Commercial office (at USIVA) has issued an order to the effect that all monetary reserves are to be consumed in full for continued new investments in each Russian-controlled factory.
- Loans falling due must be taken up with the Soviet Bank; this bank will only lend money on the strength of a tabulated entry in the Property Register (Grundbuch). In this way the Russians wish to record their rights independently of the Potsdam decisions and thereby make sure that the factories they control will become Soviet property.
