- 2. A Pan-Malayan CJA meeting will be held in Kuala Lumpur at the end of January at which time the Government will be presented with CJA amendments to the Fedoration proposals. If the Government refuses to consider the GJA amendments, this organization will call a nation-wide strike.



distributed 26 December 1945, reported the formation of the Council of Joint Action in Singapore 14 December. It is composed of left-wing associations comprising all communities. Malaya was represented by the Malay Nationalist Party. The three basic principles of the Cife wire. Inclusion of Singapore in the Federation, fully discted central togislature and equal citizenthip rights.)
