SUPPLEMENT



1. Shortly after the Nationalists recaptured Changchun, they set up a school there to train specially qualified police and intelligence men. This institution is one of five or six similar ones, all of which are branches of a parent school which was in Changking, but may have been moved to Nanking. The school at Changchun is the Northeast Branch.
2. The Generalissimo is the head of the major school. The chief of the Northeast Branch is LIU Pan (劉 璠).
3. There are over 1,000 instructors. In October there were 3,000 students, and plans had been made to increase the student body to 5,000 or 6,000 by the end of that month. The students are paid 10,000 Manchurian yuan per month while they are studying.
4. Some of the graduates serve in regular police uniform at the Changchun Municipal Police Headquarters. Others are sent out in plain clothes to do undercover work throughout Manchuria. Certain outstanding students are taught in special classes to do special underground work in Dairen and Port Arthur.
5. The school building is about 300 yards south of the Capitol Building in Changchun.
