1. The number of planes (bombers and fighters) in the 1st and 2nd Polish Air Regiments exceeds 400; they belong to the Soviet Air Force. The bombers arrived at the base in Modlin (K7L) in September 1946.
2. On 12 August 1946 Soviet planes arrived in Modlin where there were 420 planes (mostly fighters and long-range bombers) in September 1946. Soviet airmen were quartered in huts on the field.

- Comment:**
- a. The 1st and 2nd Polish Air Regiments have not yet been identified at Modlin.
 - b. On 23 January 1946 the 1st Soviet Ground Attack Air Regiment was identified at Modlin, and on 29 January 1945 the 2nd Soviet Ground Attack Air Regiment was identified at Modlin.
 - c. Possibly the above report concerns these two Soviet Ground Attack Air Regiments.)
