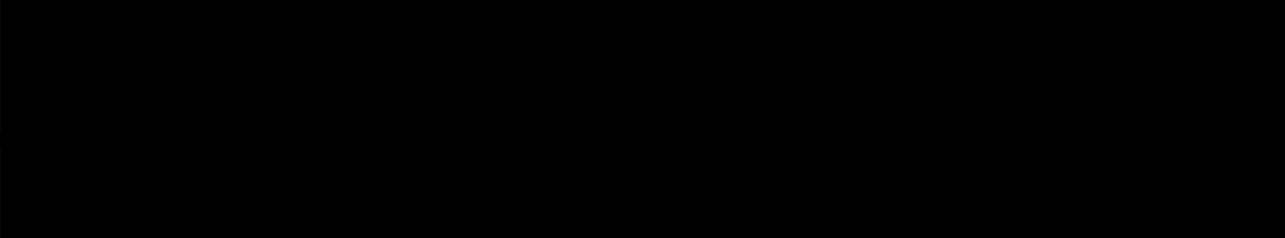

1. It is reported that T. Badnejvich, Yugoslav Minister to Lebanon (living in Cairo), came to Beirut recently and called on the Mufti of Lebanon, Muhammad Tawfiq Khalid, ^{1/300} Umar Dawq, as well as Sheikh Munir al-Muqaddam and other Moslem leaders.
2. Badnejvich told them that there are 1,300,000 Moslems in Yugoslavia, some of whom are high government officials with much prestige, and he said that his government has built schools and hospitals for these Moslems.
3. Badnejvich stated also that Moslems in Russia fare very well, much better than under the Csars.
