SUPPLEMENT



1. In late September 1946, the SMA Karlshorst allotted no gasoline to the German Central Administrations in the Russian Zone.
2. In early October 1946, the SMA itself was said to have no gasoline, as Marshal Sokolovsky requisitioned about seventy percent of the fuel produced by the Leuna works and ordered it to be stored at Baranowicze.
3. Of the gasoline produced by other firms in the Russian Zone (e.g., Erabag in R6tha (K29) near Leipzig), seventy percent is also being taken to Baranowicze for storing.
