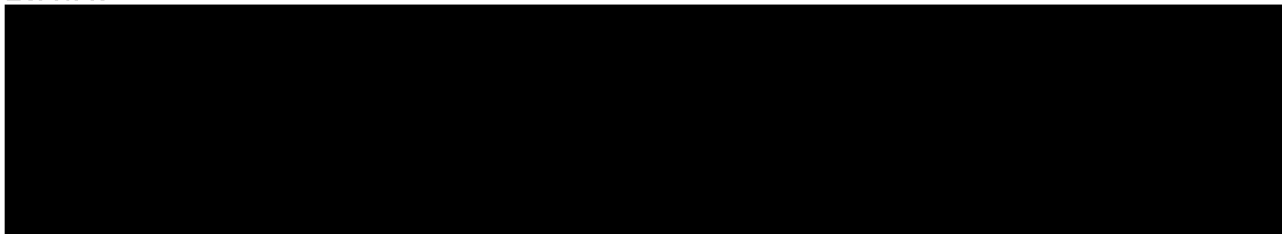

1. In Vrhnika 12 tanks, type T-34 were noted. According to local inhabitants, there are many more of these as well as a battalion of German tanks. An officer in the 2nd Tito Tank Battalion in Legatec stated that the German tanks were soon to be replaced by Russian equipment as there were no more German parts available. German and Italian equipment is now being used for training purposes only.
2. The old barracks in Ljubljana are being used as repair shops for German and Italian tanks.
