
Walesky agreed to prevent armed Chinese Communists from passing through the Soviet line and to disarm those in Soviet territory. He further agreed to abide by the Sino-Soviet Treaty. All guarantees were oral.

- 4. The Nationalists have not yet made a landing on the archipelago although it has been reported to them that there are 300 Chinese Communists on Kuanglutao (122-18, 39-10).
