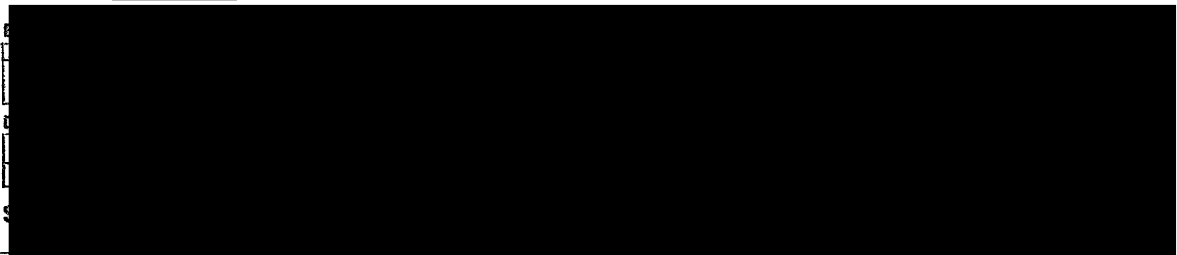

DISPOSITION AND STRENGTH OF KOREAN VOLUNTEER ARMY

The total strength of the Korean Volunteer Army in Northern Korea amounts to 20,000 troops. This army is divided into the following three corps:

- a. The Railroad Peace Preservation Corps.
- b. The Garrison Corps.
- c. The Yalu River Garrison Corps.
