SUPPLEMENT

1. The rice harvest in Macedonia has been very successful = 4,000 quintals were gathered in during October.

- 2. A sile with a capacity of 3,000 wagens of grain has been built at Mestar. Work was started in 1959 but was interrupted by the war. The sile will be used for storing grain arriving by sea at Dubrovnik and for grain harvested in the Mestar area itself.
- 5. Great importance has been attached this year to the cultivation of broom for the manufacture of textiles on the islands of the Northern Adriatic. On the island of Rab 50,000 shrubs have been planted, while 150,000 have been planted on the island of Baksi.
- 4. 1,000 head of cattle have arrived from Hungary at the state farm at Belje (Osijek). This is the second consignment of cattle to arrive from Hungary at Belje. The cattle are being supplied in payment of Hungarian reparations to Yugoslavia.
