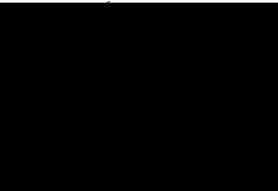

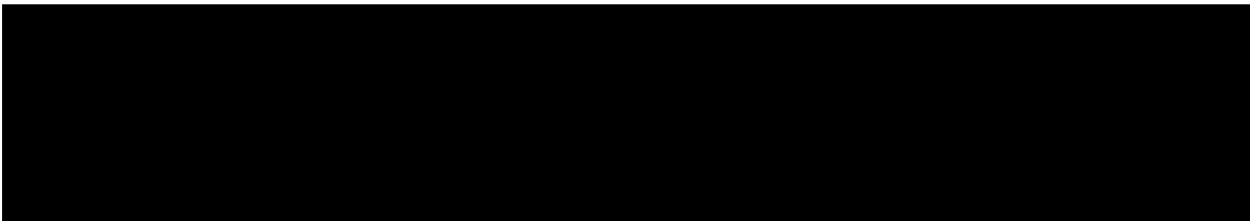

1. The textile company "Jugosvila" in Maribor which is chiefly concerned with processing artificial silk, has recently received a large consignment of silk. 75% of the goods manufactured from this must be delivered to the Soviet Union. Several other companies in Slovenia and Yugoslavia have received raw materials under the same conditions.
2. An expert from the Soviet Union has arrived at the "Jugosvila" company in Maribor, whose job it is to supervise the work and the delivery of the manufactured articles to the Soviet Union. In this way the company is directly under the control of the Soviet Union.
