Chief of Venereal Hospital in Schwarzau, about 5 km east of Neunkirchen. This hospital is exclusively for patients under first-course treatment for syphilis; for second- and third-course treatment they are under unit medical officers.

Maj FELDMAN

Chief of Department of Epidemiology.

Maj USTINOVA

Chief of Epidemiological Laboratory. Wife of Genleit USTINOV.
