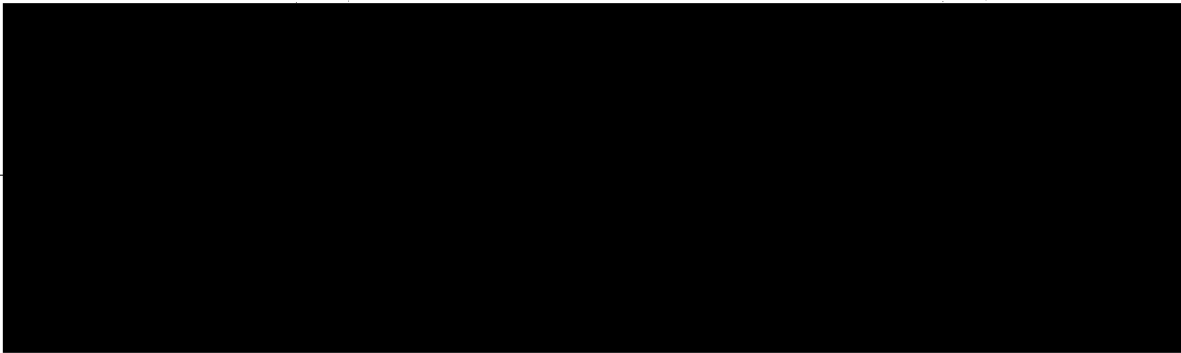

- A total of 601 ships have been raised and have undergone repairs since May 1945. Plans have been made to repair 62 self-propelled ships and 136 barges during the winter 1946-47. 30,000 tons of shipping, mostly fishing vessels, are being used for coastwise trade. This tonnage is more than sufficient for the present volume of trade; an additional 20% of goods could be carried.
- The Russians do not interfere with dispositions made by the Shipping Department and, to date, there have been ample supplies of gasoline and other fuel.
