

- Sviss Catholic conservatives have invited representatives of the CVP (Austrian Peoples' Farty), MRF (French Popular Republican Movement), Italian Demo-Christians, Belgian conservatives, Dutch conservatives, and a "certain group" of British conservatives to a conference to be held in Lucerne in late February 1947.
- 2. Rosenberg, Secretary of the Swiss Catholic Conservatives, is organizing the meeting at the suggestion of Bielka, Austrian political representative in Switzerland.
- 3. OVP delegates are to be Ferdinand Graf, State Secretary of the Interior for Austria, Felix Hurdes, Austrian Minister of Education, and Magr. Kolb.
- 4. Gamper, Deputy Landesheuptmann of Tirol, unaware of the plans for the Lucerna Conference, is still corresponding with the MRP re the Nice Conference with the Italians at Easter. He has not been invited to the opening meeting.
- 5. Giannini of Tomo Qualunque has been seeking Austrian contacts. He recently conferred with Austrian Rapul Bumbala in Italy, where he stressed the international aspects of his movement.
