[REDACTED] had a brief conversation with Ante Mandich, Chief of the Consular Section of the Yugoslav Military Delegation. During the course of the conversation, Mandich stated:

"It appears that the return of the majority of Italian PWs from Yugoslavia was useful to our interests and well-received by the Italian people. By this act we demonstrated our good will towards Italy; we could have postponed the repatriation since we still have not resumed regular diplomatic relations with Italy. Some former Italian PWs who have recently been repatriated from Yugoslavia have presented themselves to us requesting return to Yugoslavia, due to the unemployment situation in Italy. One person wrote asking to be sent back to Yugoslavia even if it meant returning to an internment camp."

2. In regards to the rumors about the trip Pietro Henri was supposed to have made to Belgrade, Mandich stated:

"From an Italian viewpoint there was very little seriousness shown. Many Italians, including those in government posts, are doing everything in their power to hinder the resumption of relations with Yugoslavia."

3. "With the re-establishment of diplomatic relations, the Italian Government, if it intends to maintain friendly Italo-Yugoslav relations, should turn over all Yugoslav refugees now in Italy to our control; it should put an end to the defamation campaign which many newspapers and Italian committees are conducting against Yugoslavia".
