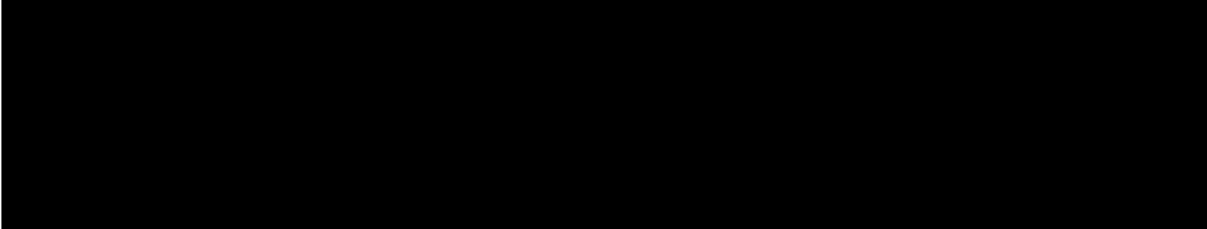

1. Julio Lopez Olivan, advisor to the Spanish Pretender Don Juan, arrived in Paris on 19 February 1947 on his way to London for whathe described as "an important conference". In Paris, he saw a highly placed French official, but no officials of the Quay d'Orsay. He conferred with Trifon Gomez, UGT Minister of Emigration in the Spanish Republican Government-in-Exile, now headed by Rodolfo Llopis, and with a representative of the CNT from Spain. The meeting was considered successful.

2. [REDACTED] rumors which have been circulating to the effect that Don Juan will come to France have no foundation. [REDACTED] that there was no immediate likelihood that the Spanish monarchists would form part of the Llopis Government.
