1. The KB R (Konstruktionsbüro Rossau - construction office of Rossau) is now located in the buildings formerly occupied by the Gebrüder Sachsenberg A.G. During the war, Gebrüder Sachsenberg A.G. was engaged for the most part in making assault boats for combat engineers.
2. At present the KB R employs about 70 engineers and technicians who are working on plans and drafts for assault boats for the Soviet Army under the direction of Maj. Nordhoff (Russian), Chief Engineer Später (German), and Deputy Lippke (German).
3. The number of persons employed at the Krupp Grusonwerk A.G. in Magdeburg, which is manufacturing equipment for cement factories on reparation contracts, is to be increased to 12,000.
