
HSIANG King (項更), former Deputy Commander of the Communist New Fourth


Army, is believed to be the highest ranking Chinese Communist in French C-5 Indo China. He was sent there to advise and support the Indo Chinese Revolutionary Army under HO Chi Minh by the Tenan Central Headquarters in October 1946. He arrived in Kweilin in the middle of October 1946 and then proceeded toward the Indo Chinese border. He was nearly captured by the Kwangsi Border Authorities before entering the country.
