1. HSIANG Ying (項英), former Deputy Commander of the Communist New Fourth Army, is believed to be the highest ranking Chinese Communist in French Indo China. He was sent there to advise and support the Indo Chinese Revolutionary Army under HO Chi Minh by the Yanan Central Headquarters in October 1946. He arrived in Kweilin in the middle of October 1946 and then proceeded toward the Indo Chinese border. He was nearly captured by the Kwangsi Border Authorities before entering the country.

2. HSIANG is still in French Indo China directing the activities of volunteers. [Redacted] note: A previous report states that HONG Ying, a Chinese Communist, went from Kweilin to Tonkin in November 1946.)
