EVALUATION OF CONTENT

- The total number of German engineers and technicians now employed in Yugoslavia is approximately 500.
- The Slovene Government plans to export 60,000 cubic meters of fire wood to the USSR in 1947.
- 3. The two textile factories in Kranj are producing a total of 12,000 to 26,000 meters of textile materials daily. Most of the production is destined for export to the USSR.
- 4. The whole of the cube sugar ("wirfelzucker") production of Yugoslavia, estimated at 30 tens daily, is exported to the USSR.
- 5. Owing to a serious shortage of cellulose, the paper industry in Slovenia may shortly be obliged to reduce production drastically.
- 6. With a view to making full use of available manpower, the Slovene and Greatian Governments are gradually replacing where possible all men employed in light work by women. This policy already reflects itself in the substitution of female labor for male labor on all buses and streetcars in Ljubljana and Zagreb. Male labor will be redirected into heavy industry.
