

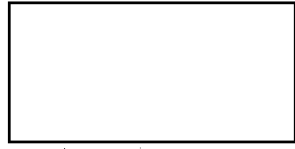

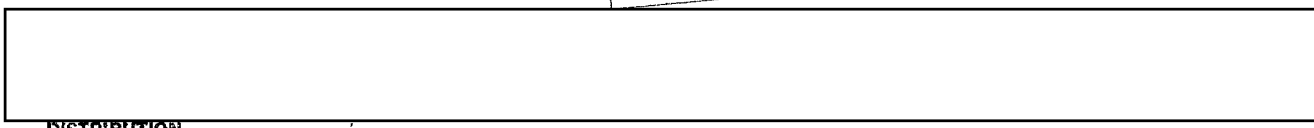
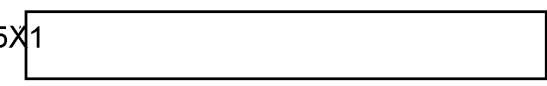

1. The Communist Party in Argentina is presently urging its Slav members who are not Argentine citizens to become naturalized in order to enable them to work more effectively in the field of labor agitation, and also to increase the voting strength of the Party.
2. The Argentine Government is opposed to granting citizenship to Slavs who are suspected of Communist sympathy, but some have been able to become naturalized through the law firm of Rois & Ciechanow, Malpu 231, Buenos Aires.
3. Very few Slavs have acquired citizenship since 1939 due to government restrictions, and also because few of them are able to pay the legal cost, which runs from 1,000 to 1,500 Argentine pesos.
