

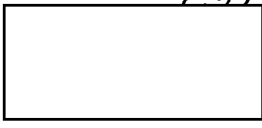

2. Neuruppin (Z49): Fifth Armored Regiment, [Redacted] equipped 25X1  
with T-34 tanks. Artillery school, [Redacted]
3. Rathenow (Z15): Artillery staff, [Redacted] plus two artillery 25X1  
regiments with approximately 120 guns of 150 mm. [Redacted] 25X1
4. Burg (Y81): An artillery corps, with approximately 20,000 men,  
stationed in this area since the middle of May 1947.
5. Weissenfels (J99): One armored "brigade".
6. Naumburg (J89): One armored-engineer battalion, subordinate to  
a division in Jena.
7. Jena (J66): Two armored "brigades", based in the former  
artillery barracks.
