1. A large number of Russian Infantrymen are equipped with the German machine pistol "Sturmgewehr 44". Others have been issued the machine gun "15 Dreyse" (sic).
2. Engineering units are being trained with the improved German "Panzerfaust 44" (Bazooka). The weapon is extremely accurate at a range of 30 to 40 meters, and is fairly accurate up to 60 meters; the maximum range is 100 meters. Instruction relative to this weapon is chiefly concerned with its use against machine gun nests, fortified positions and trenches, in house to house fighting, and as an anti-tank weapon.
3. German 8.8mm and 10.5mm anti-aircraft guns are included in the equipment of Russian anti-aircraft units. Many of these units are also equipped with German 2cm quadruple anti-aircraft guns.
4. German armored vehicles, such as the "Panther", the "Konigstieger", and the "Sturmgeschütz, type P-4", are used by Russian Panzer Units.
