1. The Pan-Slav Central Committee, which had its second meeting at Warsaw 15 + 20 June, decided that the Second Pan Slav Congress would be held at Prague in the second half of 1948.
2. In order to attract intellectuals to the Movement, the Committee decided to hold a Congress of Slav Writers and Scientists in Moscow toward the end of 1947. Professor Voznesenski, rector of Leningrad University, was appointed chairman of the steering committee of this Congress.
