1. Approximately twenty Soviet destroyers, [redacted] are at present at the Eichsteden in Swinemunde Harbor.
2. Ten former Wehrmacht motor torpedo boats are undergoing repair at the Staatswerft, Swinemunde, and a further unknown number of them are being built at these yards.
3. The former German liner "Berlin" (a hospital ship during the war) which was sunk off Usedom to the west of Swinemunde, is being raised by the Russians.
4. Repairs to the "Lutzow" continue at Swinemunde.
5. In late May a Soviet motor torpedo boat flotilla consisting of ten boats was stationed at Barhoft, the northern entrance to Stralsund. The majority of these motor boats were former Wehrmacht E-boats.
