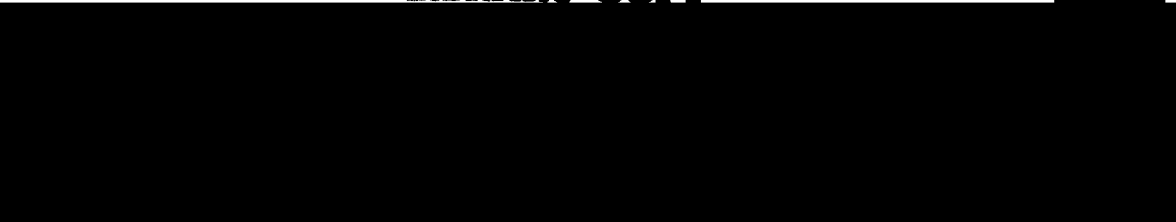

1. Soviet aircraft disposition in the Port Arthur-Dairen-Chinchou (121-43, 39-06) area is as follows:

Choushuitzu (121-33, 38-57) airfield: 48 bombers and 42 fighters

Sanchienpao (121-17, 38-55) airfield: 26 bombers and 15 fighters

Sanshihlipao (121-48, 39-16) airfield: 21 bombers and 10 fighters

Houshiatun (121-49, 39-03) airfield: 12 bombers and 3 fighters

Washington Note: See [REDACTED] 25X1A2g, reporting on these airfields.7

2. Soviet Air Corps personnel of the 13522 Unit are stationed at the Choushuitzu army barracks and the Onoda (小野田) Cement factory. They number over 1,500.

3. Three hundred bombs of 500 ratties each were transported to Sanshihlipao from Choushuitzu by the Soviets on 17 July 1947.
